1. EXTENT OF AUTONOMY

Granting committees complete autonomy in the execution of their tasks is a commendable approach to empower them for effective decision-making and implementation. The commitment to enhancing the efficiency of these committees is further underscored by the principal's willingness to allocate clerical, infrastructural, and supporting staff assistance as needed. This demonstrates a proactive stance in facilitating the smooth functioning of the committees by providing essential resources.

2. DECISION-MAKING

Decisions made by a committee in pursuit of its fundamental objectives and goals are ideally reached through consensus, fostering a sense of team spirit and unity of purpose, thus generating synergistic outcomes. The committee is granted the autonomy to establish its own rules and procedures for operation, with the understanding that these rules require the approval of the principal for enforcement. To ensure transparency and accountability, all deliberations during committee meetings should be meticulously recorded, and the presence of members duly attested.

A quorum for a meeting is constituted by two-thirds of the committee members. If a meeting is postponed due to a lack of quorum, and on a subsequent date, two-thirds of the members fail to attend, the meeting can still proceed with the presence of fifty percent of the total committee members, making any decisions taken therein valid. This framework is designed to balance flexibility with accountability, promoting effective decision-making within the committee while upholding necessary standards and procedures.

It is imperative for each committee to formulate both an annual plan and an annual schedule to guide its actions and attain its objectives efficiently. This strategic approach aids in organizing tasks, promoting better coordination, and ensuring optimal functioning within the committee. The annual plan serves as a blueprint, outlining the committee's goals, priorities, and the steps required to achieve them over the course of the year. Meanwhile, the annual schedule provides a time-bound framework, allowing for the systematic execution of tasks and the timely accomplishment of milestones.

3. COMMITTEE REPORT

Each committee is required to submit an annual report to IQAC, encompassing crucial information to provide a comprehensive overview of its activities. This report should include details on the targets set for the year, offering a clear understanding of the committee's intended accomplishments. Subsequently, the report should evaluate the committee's performance in attaining these targets, highlighting successes and challenges faced during the implementation of action plans.
